1. Each patient will be asked a series of health questions aimed at identifying any risk factors prior to coming to the office. The goal is to reduce the risk of having a Covid-19 positive patient entering the clinic.
2. Reduced traffic flow in the office. We will be treating fewer patients for the time being. It will also allow us time to get accustomed to the new operating protocols.
3. We have installed a number of air purifying units throughout the office. These units are designed to filter out any Corona virus that may be present in the air. Although these units have not been mandated for office use, we feel they are worth the investment.
4. Certain dental procedures generate aerosols. Since transmission of the Corona virus is by airborne droplet spread, this is an obvious concern. The use of a chairside vacuum system will address this issue.
5. We have always exercised universal precautions, but there will be enhanced disinfecting protocols. High traffic areas will be routinely wiped down.
6. The use of personal protective equipment which includes; gloves, gown, surgical mask/respirator. and face shield.
